A Word from our Chairman

Even before Covid-19, we were mindful of the need to further digitalize.

After an initial study, we appointed a service provider last year to help us set up an Integrated IT Care and Management System. It will help us better monitor and track resident care thereby enabling our staff to optimize their delivery of care to our residents.

The system can better track, for example, doctor appointments; when the residents last sent their laundry for washing; residents' dietary, grooming, counselling and physiotherapy needs and history records.

It will also seamlessly integrate the various standalone platforms we now have e.g. the billing system and the donation management system with the accounting system. We look forward to improved work efficiency with its implementation in early 2021.

Construction work on our new Home has resumed from September with the Government's easing of some of the measures against Covid-19. All safe management measures will continue to be enforced. With this resumption, we also look forward to moving into our new Home by June 2021.

在冠状病毒19大流感之前,我们就已经 意识到需要进一步数码化。

经过初步研究后,我们去年选了一位 承包商来协助我们建立集成的关爱和 管理 信息技术 系统。这将有助于我 们更好地监控和跟踪居民的照料,从 而使我们的员工能够优化向居民的照料。 料。

该系统可以更好地跟踪,例如,医生 预约;居民最后一次把衣服送去洗衣 服务的时间;居民的饮食,美容,辅 导和物理治疗需求以及病历记录。

它还将无缝集成我们现有的各种独立平台,例如把计费系统和捐赠管理系统与会计系统集成。我们期待在2021年初通过新系统的实施,提高工作效率。

由于政府放松了针对防止冠状病毒-19的某些措施,我们的新家园的建筑工作已于9月恢复。所有安全管理措施将继续执行。通过这次恢复,我们也期待在2021年6月前迁移新家园。
